INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 2: Review the shopping list and instructions below. Please focus on getting new items.

STEP 3: Discuss how your group will collect or purchase the needed items. Feel free to invite others (neighbors and co-workers) to donate as well.

STEP 4: Gather your donated items and meet as a group to spend some time praying for the families that will receive the items.

STEP 5: Donations can be dropped off Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
