STAR House Foundation provides after-school tutoring and mentoring for at-risk children throughout North Fulton County. They currently serve over 250 children through four Roswell school programs and often have a waiting list. Their summer camp bridges the gap for 120 students at the elementary level, focusing on academic retention so students do not lose necessary skills over summer break. At both their after-school program and summer camp, STAR House has book carts that give the students an opportunity to read. Some of the students are given books to take home so they can build their own library. Your small group can help by providing books for their students.
